Youth-Adult Research Partnership Five-Stage Project Plan

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
Planning

First, the adults will do a little homework to learn more about you (the students) and your school.



Partnering

Next, we will decide together what our goals are, how we will make decisions, and how we will know if things are going well.



Training

Then we will all learn <u>new</u> skills to help us gather more information- things like how to interview students, how to improve survey questions, and how to look at data and figure out what it means.



Sharing
