### HISTORY OF THE LAND

- North Minneapolis has a history of economic disinvestment on a basis of class and race
- Discriminatory deeds kept Black people out of many neighborhoods in Minneapolis causing them to be pushed over North. The results of redlining can still be seen today
- Has had a major Black presence since the 1900s.
